The Board of Trustees of Harris Township, Ottawa County, met in regular session on Monday, March 7, 2022, with the following officials present: Trustees Beverly Haar, Jerry Haar, DJ Greenhill (entered at 7:48), and Fiscal Officer Laura Hazel. Chairman Beverly Haar called the meeting to order at 7:30 pm.

The minutes of the February 14, 2022, regular meeting, were read by Chairman Beverly Haar and approved on a motion made by Jerry Haar and seconded by Beverly Haar. **Motion** carried.

FINANCIAL

A motion was made by Jerry Haar and seconded by DJ Greenhill that the attached list of bills totaling \$29,575.86 be approved as the lawful obligations of Harris Township and that the Fiscal Officer be permitted to issue warrants in favor of the same. **Motion carried.**

REPORTS

Financial/Administrative:

- 1. December 2021 bank reconciliation and financial reports were reviewed and accepted by Board of Trustees.
- 2. The 2021 annual financial report was submitted and notice was sent for publication to the *Suburban Press*.
- 3. ARPA reallocation distribution to NEUs provided an additional \$323.68 to the township.
- 4. Trustees approved 2022 vacation for Rodriguez and approved carryover of 8 hours to be used on 5/25/2022.
- 5. Due to Final CRF revisions, Fiscal Officer reported that Q4-2021 and Q1-2022 reports were amended and \$383.80 will be returned for unexpended appropriations and interest to the state of Ohio.

Zoning: (no report)

Cemetery:

- 1. Andy Rodriguez placed annual cemetery spring clean-up notice in the Suburban Press.
- 2. Fiscal officer will post the job opening for part time cemetery seasonal mowing on line.

Roads:

 Road resurfacing prioritization discussion took place. Culvert lining will be done on Portage River South just west of Harris Salem Road. Lickert-Harder will have wedge repairs along the berms and chip/seal resurfacing. Slemmer Portage (south of Elmore East) was being considered for 2022 resurfacing. However, it was cold patched by the township road crew last fall and seems to be holding up well. Recently, Linker-Portage (south of Elmore East) has shown more deterioration. B. Haar will contact the county engineers to determine if its condition warrants more immediate action than Slemmer. Cost estimates will be obtained for Reclamite, a road preservative application, for Portage River South (SR 590 to Slemmer) and Hessville (Elmore East to county line).

EMS/Fire:

- 1. The EMS pay incentive will be continued through 2022.
- 2. An estimate of \$985 was received to replace the damaged door panel in #449's bay. It will take between 14-16 weeks for the panel to arrive. The bay door for #447 is rusting and it was recommended that a panel also be ordered for this door as well. Additionally, the door openers on all the bays are obsolete and consideration should be given to replacing them as well.
- 3. The Ottawa County fire chiefs will meet at our station on March 16
- 4. The annual county engineers' meeting with township officials will take place April 12 at the county fairgrounds and the topics will center around bridge loading.
- 5. Six to eight firefighters will be attending the Northwest Ohio training school at Penta on March 12 and will take an apparatus to the session.
- 6. Hose replacements have been ordered and will cost approximately \$360.
- 7. After a recent fire incident at Materion, the company will replace a \$1014 piercing nozzle that was damaged and will cover the cost of compressor maintenance. Approval granted to order a spare nozzle.
- 8. Washington Township in Sandusky County is donating approximately \$5,000 to several area departments that service the township. Chief Wilburn is considering the following items: nozzles, wet suits, cold water winter rescue wet suits, and an accountability response board.
- 9. A number of helmets will be out of date by July. An inventory is being made of the current helmets to see how many will need replacement. The annual budget has been adjusted to include annual replacement for a number of sets of gear including helmets.

Building/Grounds

- 1. Pat and Sons towing will remove the storage semi trailer north of the station. Its original purpose as a training drill site was not completed due to increased cost of material.
- 2. Wilburn reported that the drywall repairs are continuing.
- 3. Ants have returned to the station and the exterminator will be spraying this week.

Communications, Announcements and other:

- 1. The annual March delivery assistance request from Senior Resources Meals on Wheels was received.
- 2. The Ottawa County Health Department Advisory Council annual meeting will be March 10 at 6 pm. Greenhill plans to attend.
- 3. The Regional Planning CDBG program will be March 31 at 1:30.
- 4. Hazard Mitigation Assistance Grant pre-application is due March 25 at the Emergency Management Agency.
