- 1. Request received for American Legion memorial services contribution for 2021. Previous years contribution \$200; Hazel to contact Legion to find out associated expenses in consideration of modifying annual contribution.
- 2. Corrigan Oil selling Elmore Express Shop to GPM SouthEast LLC. New agreement received, which will be reviewed by Fiscal Officer before presenting to board for signatures. Options for information to be included with billing (i.e., odometer, employee #).
- OTARMA liability and property/casualty insurance renewal received and will be reviewed by Fiscal Officer and Trustees.

Roads:

- 1. Superintendent's report:
 - a. Windows are in; flagpole set up; taking compressor to Moriarty for repair

Fire/EMS:

- 1. Chief's report:
 - a. Hose testing completed. (1) 1.75"x50' hose and (2) 3"x50' hose to be replaced, \$708.85.
 - b. Twenty-nine attended pump testing comradery dinner at Frickers afterwards. Receipt submitted for \$675.
 - c. Probationary period extension of six months for J. Bretzloff.
 - d. Resignation accepted for T. Yarger upon sale of home and relocation to Bowling Green.
 - e. Application received from Craig Berman, who recently resigned from Portage Fire and would like to join HEFD. He lives 7 miles outside of Harris Township towards Oak Harbor. He has 8+ years of experience. HEFD Officers have approved application and are recommending to the Board for approval. Bev Haar moved to approve applicant; Jerry Haar seconded the motion. **Motion carried.** Berman sent to Elmore PD for background check.
 - f. Turnout gear was ordered from Phoenix. Hazel requested confirmation of order and pricing.
 - g. S. Jones rescinded his resignation after discussion with HEFD Officers and has resumed activities with the Fire and EMS departments.
 - h. McGinnis to obtain new quote for Marcs radios for grant project.
- 2. Chief Engineer N. Overmyer reported:
 - a. Explained need for additional 2-1/2 to 1-3/4" reducers to add on an additional hose line or two if needed for new engine #442. Pricing estimated at \$40 each for (2) hose reducers, and \$27 each for (2) hose caps. Trustees approved purchase.
 - b. Quote received for #443 for hose reducer valve and other valve rebuilding from Williams for \$5,810. This has been an issue for the past several years, as American LaFrance engines are no longer built and the engine has not passed the suction test. Several valves are noted as failed and must be replaced; others are on their way due to leaks. Tank to pump reduction from 4" to 3" valve. Elmore water attributes to the severe wear on the plastic ball valves. Discussion on whether the repairs should be done as needed or as a whole. Overmyer stated these valve repairs should last another 20 years. Service (LOF) also needs completed on #443. Schematics book provided to Williams to assist with repairs and options. Hazel requested decision wait until May so appropriations can be confirmed.
 - c. Alignment still needs to be completed for #446 at Speck Sales in BG.
- 3. Berkel happy with new pricing structure from Williams and stated former Engineer A. Katko confirmed pricing is "unbelievable." Both agreed that we couldn't buy filters and oil for their pricing. Maintenance folders have been set up by Williams and copies will be provided to HEFD under new structure.
- 4. Berkel announced that HEFD open house will be moved to 6/27, same time as Portage River Festival, since the Explore Elmore Days has been cancelled. Activities include jump house, ladder rides, smoke trailer safety

- training for kids, and general promotion/awareness of Fire/EMS activities and equipment.
- 5. Washington Township fire contract expires 6/14/2021. Five-year renewal requested by Washington Township fiscal officer, Lori Crispen, to coincide with their levy. After discussion with Chief Wilburn, J. Haar moved to renew at same rate, \$7,500/annual, beginning 6/15/2021 and ending 6/14/2026. B. Haar seconded the motion. **Motion carried.**
- 6. Asst. Chief/EMS report:
 - a. #449 air conditioning has been recharged at LH Automotive
 - Approval to schedule #448 patient care camera install and repairs, change fluorescent lighting in patient care area to LED, approximately \$5,000
 - c. Quote received for #449 modem: \$500 modem; P&R to install (run power to modem) quoted at time/material estimated at \$500 for two hours; McGinnis will program.
 - d. #448 modem to be assessed for same
 - e. Request to purchase (4) sets of ballistic gear before Rescue Task Force training. Special bulk pricing agreement with Sandusky County EMS for approximately \$1200 each. Trustees to consider for approval at next meeting.
 - f. N. Zimmerman has passed his EMT-B national certification
 - g. K. Fertig has withdrawn her request for paramedic school tuition reimbursement program for 2021.

Building/Grounds:

1. Amplex scheduled to begin install this week of internet and phones.
