A motion was made by Carol Baker and seconded by Beverly Haar that the preceding list of bills totaling \$39,509.67 be approved as the lawful obligations of Harris Township and that the Fiscal Officer be permitted to issue warrants in favor of the same. Upon calling the roll, the motion was unanimously approved. **Motion carried.**

REPORTS:

Fiscal Officer:

- 1. Township Fiscal Officer still working with UAN on troubleshooting computer problems attributed to latest Windows update.
- Trustee Baker continues to work with Prosecutor's office on 2019 Village
 of Elmore annexation on Portage River South (east) and tax revenue loss,
 along with current notifications regarding Type 2 expedited filing
 annexations for Portage River South (west towards Schedels) and
 property on Dischinger Rd.
- 3. Baker did an annual check on employee/volunteer BMV records.
- 4. Fiscal Officer requested direction on full-time employee time card variances with time clock reports. Baker moved to begin paying from time clock reports, with a 5-minute grace period on the quarter hour for clock in/out, effective 9/21/2020. If employee has any issue with time clock, notification is to be sent to Fiscal Officer by text or email for approval. Beverly Haar seconded the motion. **Motion carried.**
- 5. Trustees agreed that Network Analysis Project Phase I recommendations should be sent to OTARMA IT Risk representative for review before proceeding with Phase II.

Cemetery:

- 1. Water leak in cemetery continues to remain unidentified. Nate Gaines used divining rods, dowsing the area to locate water below the surface. There seems to be an area near Schultz Portage Rd where the water main comes in that is of interest. Trustees agreed to keep water turned off, but to pursue options for placing new lines and mapping out in spring 2021. There is a company in Carey, OH, along with Zimmerman Construction that may do this type of excavating that we can get a quote for budgeting and planning purposes.
- 2. New deeds and transfers #614 through #620 were reviewed and signed.

Roads:

- 1. Jerry Haar in contact with the Engineer's Office regarding obtaining an easement from Rothert to move poles in ditch on Witty Rd.
- 2. Witty Rd to be closed to repair dip in road due to broken clay tile, which will need dug out, filled in with stone and hot mix placed.

Fire/EMS:

- 1. McGinnis provided information received from Walk In Urgent Care for flat rate fee to provide annual fire fighter testing to include physical, fitness testing, vaccinations, lab work, and five-year chest x-ray with reading for a discount fee of \$410/person up to 30 fire fighters, \$12,300 total. This is much more reasonable compared to the \$30,000 quoted for the in-house company. Trustee B. Haar moved to approve and instructed Fiscal Officer to issue purchase order and McGinnis to proceed with scheduling for October and November. Jerry Haar seconded the motion. Fiscal officer said a reallocation of appropriations may be necessary and was instructed by trustees to reallocate appropriations as necessary.
- 2. Portable air scrubbers ordered from O.E. Meyer. Still researching UV lights, and dispensers for sanitizer/soap.
- 3. Discussion on personnel: specifically, EMT candidate who is taking course over, new employee, tuition reimbursement for EMT candidate, and termination returned for change of address.
- 4. Vanguard offering Fire/EMT Instructor course for \$550 tuition/including books, and Paramedic program for \$7300 tuition/including books and testing fees, A&P also required for \$425 tuition. This information can be considered in capping our tuition programs. No action taken at this time.
- 5. Squad #449 going in for oil change at DPM.

Zoning:

- 1. Babjack provided biweekly update on junk vehicles on SR-590 and Slemmer Portage, as well as business on SR-105.
- Complaint received from resident on shed going up on W. Portage River S. Rd near Riverside Drive. Babjack will follow up with county on building permit.

Building/Grounds:

- 1. The Firearms/weapon policy was revised per recommendation of Chief Wilburn. Beverly Haar moved to accept revisions as part of Harris Township handbook; Carol Baker seconded the motion. **Motion carried**.
- 2. Trustees approved upgrading plan with Time Warner/Spectrum from the 15x2 program to a 200x20 (upload/download) plan at a reduce monthly cost. There is no contract required; month to month. The modem/equipment may need upgraded as well, but cost should not exceed \$100.

Communications, Announcements, Other:

- 1. Trustees received and reviewed Grassroots Clippings September 2020; Ottawa County Community Foundation, Summer 2020; OTA Cares Act
- 2. Request for letter of commendation for Eagle Scout Aden Carter, along with invitation to ceremony to be held on Oct 11 at 2pm at Grace Church, Elmore.
