A Resolution to proceed with purchase of two acres of land adjacent to Union Cemetery from Richard Yeasting.

Whereas, Richard Yeasting has agreed to sell two parcels of land in the Southwest Quarter of Section 17, T6N, R14E, Harris Township, Ottawa County, specifically parcel (1) 2.144 acres at \$6,000/acre and parcel (2) 0.248 acre at \$0.00/acre, for future grave sites and cemetery usage in Union Cemetery, for a total contract price of \$12,864.00;
