New Business

Beverly Haar introduced the following resolution and moved for its passage:

RESOLUTION TO APPOINT BOND COUNSEL IN CONNECTION WITH PROPOSED BOND ISSUE

WHEREAS, Harris Township, Ottawa County, Ohio is considering issuing general obligation, limited tax bonds to fund the purchase of a building for its road and cemetery departments, under the authority of the general laws of the State of Ohio, and in particular Revised Code Section 505.262 thereof, (the "Bonds"); and

WHEREAS, the law firm of Bricker Graydon, LLP, is experienced in serving as bond counsel on financings of this type;

NO, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Township Trustees of the Township of Harris, Ottawa County, Ohio, that:

Section 1 – The firm of Bricker Graydon, LLP, is hereby approved to serve as bond hereby authorizes and directs the Fiscal Officer to execute on behalf of the Board any additional items as may be appropriate or necessary to evidence such bond counsel relationship,

Section 2 – It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of the Board concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of the Board, and that all deliberations of the Board and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Revised Code Section 121.22.

Mr. Jerry Haar seconded the motion and, after discussion, a roll call vote was taken and the results were:

Rodriguez relayed comments from village residents questioning why the Township
junk day can't be used by them in addition to the Village junk day, as Village
residents pay taxes to both the Village and the Township. He would like guidance in
how to respond to these types of questions. Upon further researching, the Village
currently pays for a "Solid Waste" levy that is set to expire soon, with talk of not
renewing. This provides Village residents with curbside pickup and monthly junk day
dumpster, at an average cost of \$106/year. Township tax collections for the general

fund average \$40/year per household, of which junk collection is only a small part. More review on future junk collections needs to be done in anticipation of the Village changing their services to residents.
