## **Approval of Minutes**

- Jones returned all equipment except EMS uniforms. Wilburn questioned if Hazel or McGinnis has reached out to him about reapplying for EMS part-time. Hazel will discuss with McGinnis.

He also moved to appoint Captain Mike "Toby" Murray as chair of said personnel committee, who will organize a committee of 2 officers and 3 non-officer volunteer/part-time employees not involved with appeal/grievance. Trustee J Haar seconded the motion to form committee and appoint Murray as chairman. Motion carried.
